

SPRinT Online Simulation Faculty Development Course

This is an innovative and interactive on-line simulation facilitator course designed for all health care professionals with an interest in simulation, and how simulation can be used in the healthcare arena to enrich learning, enhance individual & team performance, and improve patient safety.

It is run over two days on Teams to maximise participant interaction and learning. Expert SPRinT faculty provide knowledge of the principles of adult learning, debriefing theory, learning cycles and how simulation complements multi-disciplinary team performance. Videos of real simulated scenarios and online participation in teaching provide an authentic learning experience aimed to maximise skill development.
